## **LESSON GOALS**

Speaking, reading and writing connecting Anishinaabemowin numbers.

Book: Aambe Gendaaswidaa Shi Shi cards

## **LESSON IDEAS**

Introduce how to connect Anishinaabemowin numerals by reading book five from the Aambe Gendaaswidaa: Shi.

Introduce the "Shi" activity cards. Use the language introduced in the book, by asking, "Aaniish ezhi kidiyin 11" and continue asking the same question using other numerals. Consider focusing on two-digit numerals before introducing three and four-digit numerals, and base next steps on learner readiness.

Anishinaabemowin language use:

- Aaniish ezhi kidiyin <u>11</u> Anishinaabemyiing? How do you say <u>11</u> in Anishinaabemowin?
- Nahaa, zhinimooshin. Ok, show me.

11 midaaswi SHI bezhik

- Aaniish ezhi kidiyin <u>252</u> Anishinaabemyiing? How do you say <u>252</u> in Anishinaabemowin?
- Wegnesh waa zhinimooshin <u>niizhwak shi naanimdinaa shi niish</u>? Who wants to match <u>niizhwak shi naanimdinaa shi niish</u>?

252 niizhwak SHI naanimdinaa SHI niish

- Aaniish ezhi kidiyin <u>4681</u> Anishinaabemyiing? How do you say <u>4681</u> in Anishinaabemowin?
- Wegnesh waa zhinimooshit <u>niiwining midaaswak shi ngodwaaswak shi</u> nshwaasmidnaa shi bezhik?

# Lesson ideas continue...

Consolidation - reinforce learning by playing a game in 2-4 groups. "zhinimooshin" Each member of the group will take turns creating 2 to 4-digit numbers using the shi and numeral cards and the rest of the group will give the answers of the numeral that was created.

## Anishinaabemowin language use:

- Wenesh maanda gendaaswin Anishinaabemyiing? What is this number in Anishinaabemowin?
- Niin ntam! My turn!
- Kiin ntam! Your turn!
- Ehn! gdebwe! Yes! You are right!
- Ka! gaawii gdebwe sii! No! You are not right!
- Oooh eta gegaa! Oooh almost right!

#### **LESSON IDEAS**

If learners are ready, introduce the Gendaaswin Boggle game. Students will select a numeral of their choice from the Gendaaswin Boggle number chart. They will then create as many two, three or four-digit number of their choice. Follow the point system on the game board to see who created the most points from using Shi. The Gendaaswin Boggle game can be played as a two-player or more while assessing learners.

Assess individual learners during the Gendaaswin Boggle activity by using the assessment sheet.
